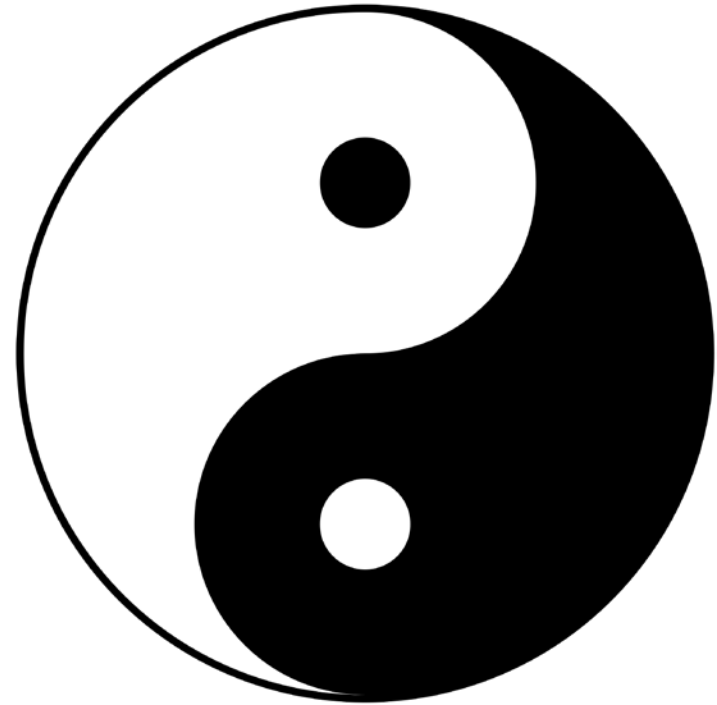
Regional Climate Planning

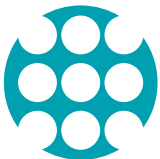

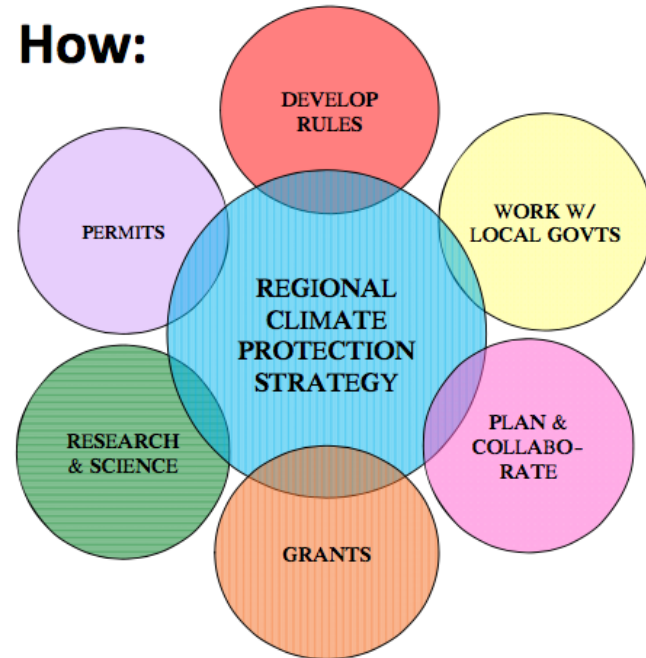

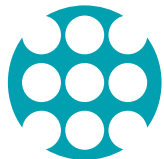

Roles & Responsibilities

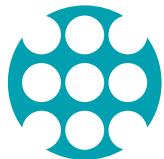
Based on Existing Resources and Stakeholder Input:
